



Daisy bead

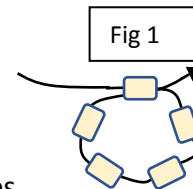
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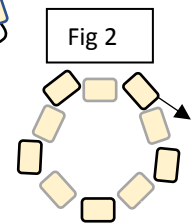
Materials, small quantities of each.
15 x 8 mm oval wooden bead
Delica beads in M for the main colour,
Delica second colour D for your daisies.
Size 15 duracoat gold beads, for the
daisy centres-C.
KO thread or nymo D in complementary colour
Size 10 needle.

Step 1

Row 1 Thread on 5 M beads, tie in a double knot and exit the first bead added. *See fig 1*

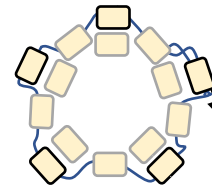


Row 2 Pick up one, pass through the next, repeat 4 times. Step up at the end of the round. *See fig 2*



Row 3 Peyote, pick up 1M, miss one, pass through the next. *See fig 3*

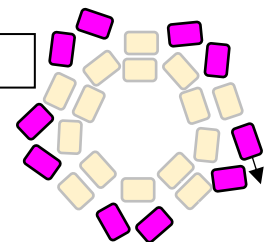

Daisies are show as a single colour, but you could choose to have each daisy a different colour.

Row 4 Add 2D beads in each space and step up through first one added. *See fig 4*

Row 5 Place a C bead in the centre of each double D and an M bead in the alternative spaces. *See fig 5*

Row 6 Single D beads in this round. *See fig 6*

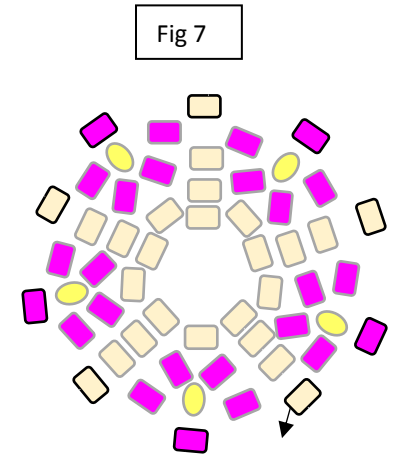
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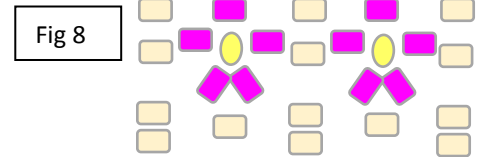
Row 7 One D bead to complete each daisy and an M bead in the other spaces. Your first round of daisies is complete, using five D beads for each. *See fig 7*

The next daisy will use six D beads for each.

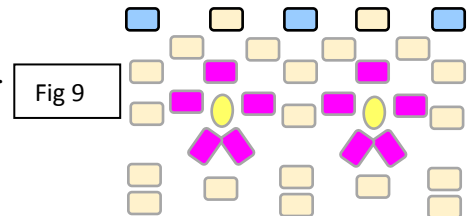


Converting to vertical diagrams now to show the next daisy.

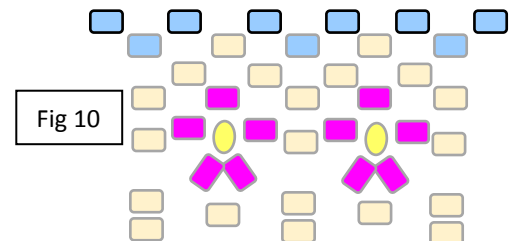
Row 8 M beads only in this round. *See fig 8*



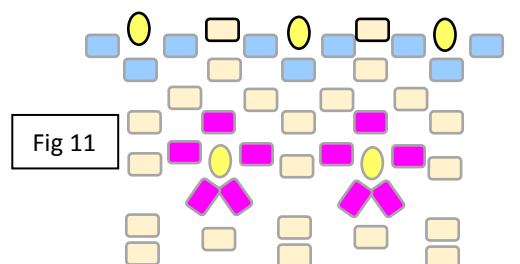
Row 9 Place a D bead in between the previous daisies, and M beads in the alternate spaces. *See fig 9*



Row 10 D bead round. *See fig 10*



Row 11 Place a C bead in the centre of each daisy and an M bead alternately. *See fig 11*





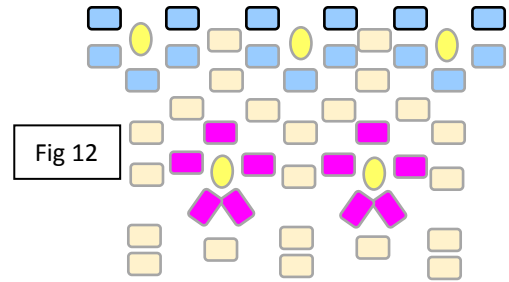
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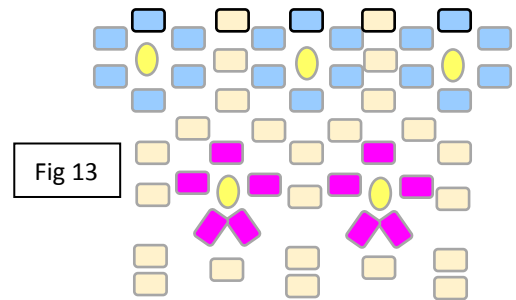
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Insert the wooden bead if you haven't already done so

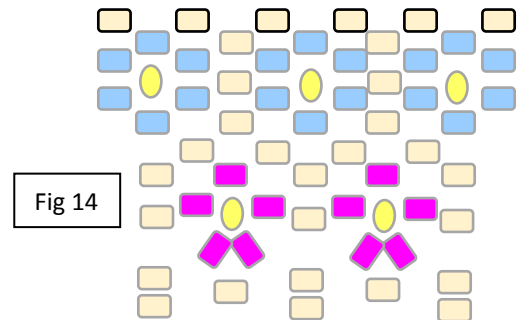
Row 12 Another D bead round. *See fig 12*



Row 13 A single D to complete each daisy and Ms in the other spaces. *See fig 13*

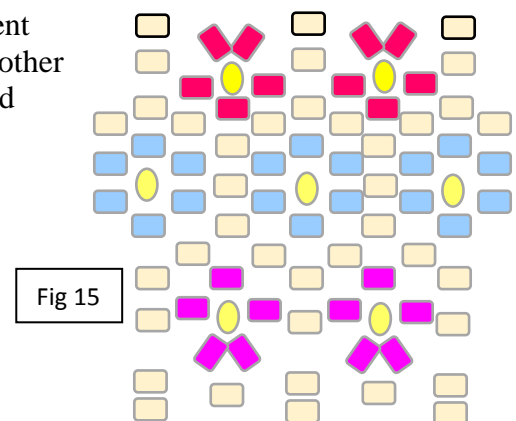


Row 14 A round of M beads. *See fig 14*



Repeat from 9 to 12 inclusive.

Row 15 In this row you will sew the two adjacent Ds together, and add an M bead in the other spaces. This will complete the five bead daisy set. *See fig 15*





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Rows 16
&17

Add M beads,
See fig 16, row 16 black outline,
row 17 brown outline.
Sew through the last round added again
and finish off, then sew in the thread at the
other end.

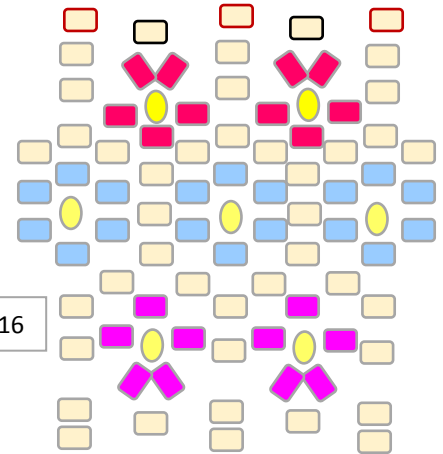
