TOOLS REQUIRED

Size 10 Beading Needle (ND10)
A Sharp pair of Scissors

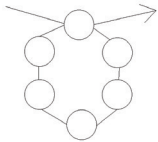
MATERIALS

5g x 11/0 Pearlescent White Seed Beads (P1102C) (W)
5g x 11/0 Opaque Yellow Seed Beads (O803C) (A)
5g x 11/0 Opaque Orange Seed Beads (O821C) (B)
5g x 11/0 Silver Lined Red Seed Beads (S1111C) (C)
5g x 11/0 Matte Metallic Red Gold Seed Beads (ME1126C) (D)
5g x 11/0 Silver Lined Pink Seed Beads (S1122C) (E)
5g x 11/0 Rainbow Purple Seed Beads (R1113C) (F)
5g x 11/0 Silver Lined Lilac Seed Beads (S1124C) (G)
5g x 11/0 Opaque Royal Blue Seed Beads (O1117C) (H)
5g x 11/0 Silver Lined Turquoise Seed Beads (S1118C) (I)
5g x 11/0 Silver Lined Emerald Seed Beads (S1116C) (J)
5g x 11/0 Rainbow Green Seed Beads (R1116C) (K)
5g x 11/0 Opaque Green Seed Beads (O1139C) (L)
12 x 4mm Fire Polished Clear AB Beads (GLPE0405)
1 reel of White Beading Thread (NMD02)

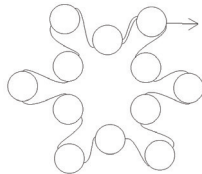
INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Thread your needle with a comfortable length of stretched beading thread, leaving a 15cm tail, pick up 6W. Circle around and pass through all the beads again to form a circle, then pass through the 1st W again. (Picture 1)
- 2 Pick up 1W and pass through the next W. Repeat around and step up through the 1st bead added. (Picture 2)
- 3 Pick up 3W and pass through the next W from step 2. Repeat around and step up through the 1st 2 beads added. (Picture 3)

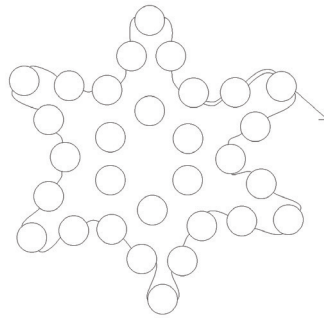
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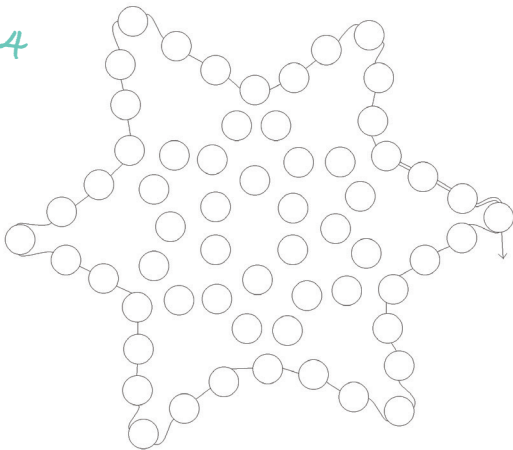
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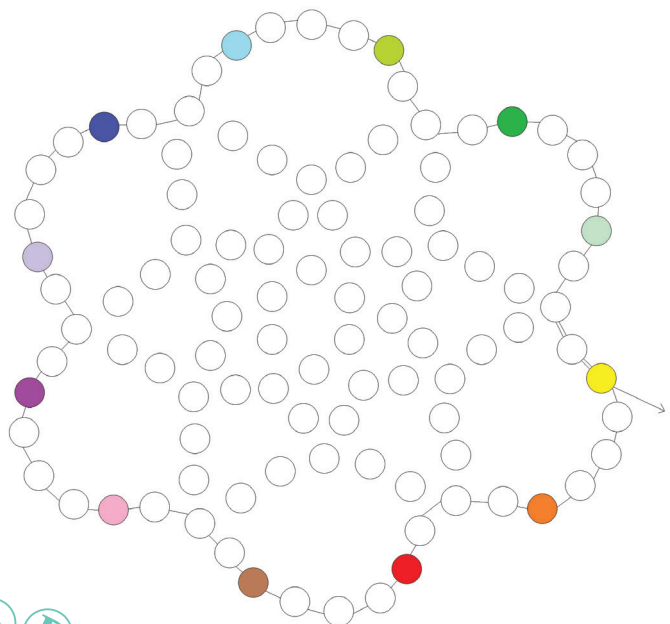
- 4 Pick up 5W and pass through the next central bead from step 3. Repeat around and step up through the 1st 3 beads added. (Picture 4)

- 5 Pick 1W, 1A, 3W, 1B and 1W, pass through the next central bead from step 4. Repeat around changing the colours of beads picked up as shown below. Step up to exit from the A bead. (Picture 5)

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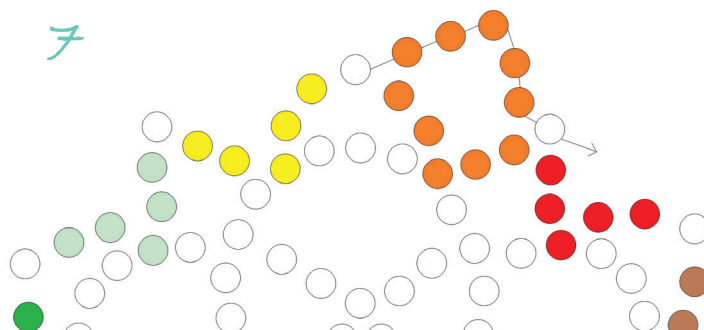
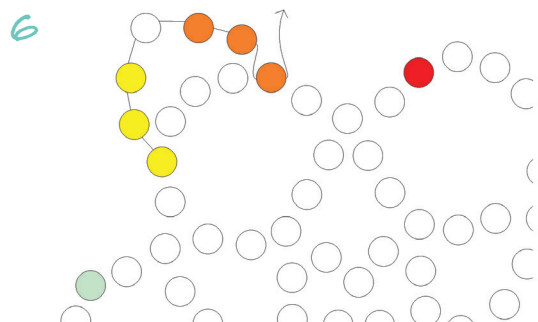


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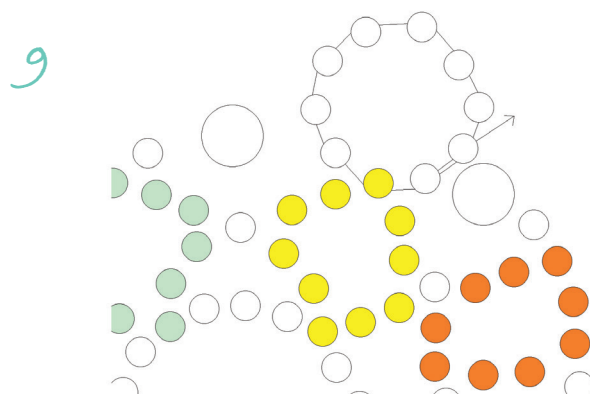
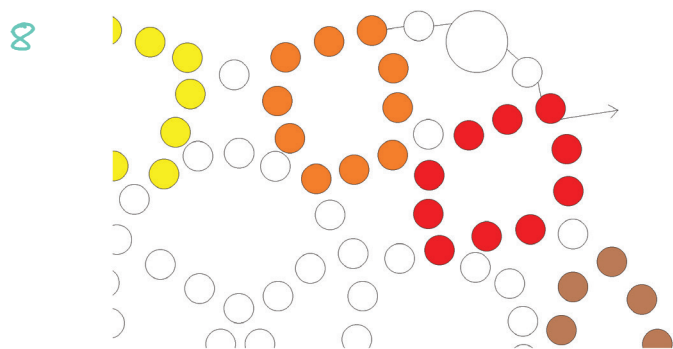
6 Pick up 2A, 1W and 2B and pass through the B from step 5 (Picture 6). Repeat around altering colours as necessary. Step up through 2A and 1W.

7 Pick up 5B and pass through the next W from step 6 (Picture 7). Repeat around altering the colours as necessary. Step up through 3B.



8 Pick up 1W, a 4mm and 1W and pass through the next central bead from step 7. Repeat around. (Picture 8)

9 If you would like a loop to hang this pendant from, weave around the outside edge to exit the W after the A tip bead. Pick up 7W and circle through the W, A and W. Weave around this loop a couple of times to strengthen. Weave in and secure your threads. (Picture 9)
