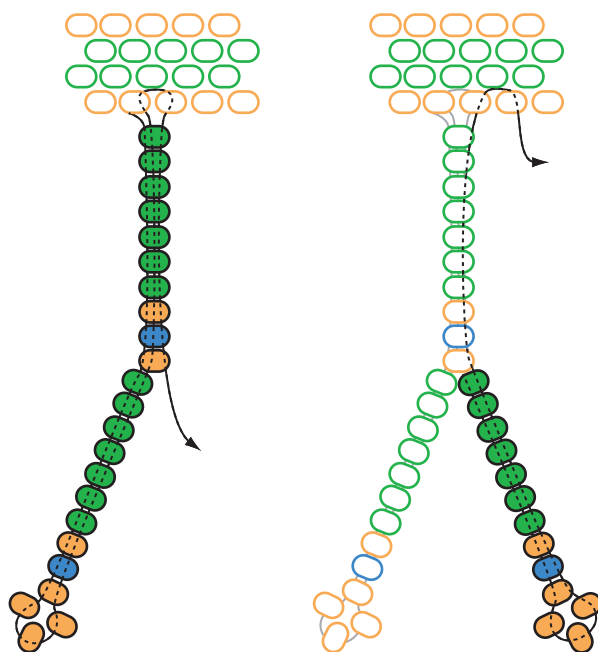

The Tassel

1. Make a band of Peyote stitch four beads wide by ten rows long and seam the two ends together to form a tube.
2. To add the fringes, follow the diagrams below.

The Braid

Use beads in two colours: Main (M) and Contrast (C).

1. Pick up 1C, 1M, 1C, 2M, 1C, 1M and go through the first bead again.
2. * Pick up 2M, 1C, 1M and go through the C of the previous group.
3. Repeat from * until the braid is the length required.
