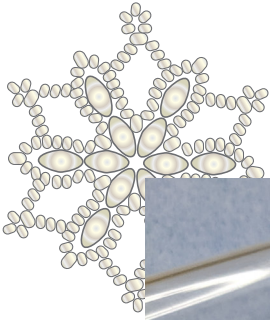
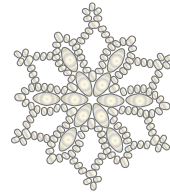


# Wee Snowflakes

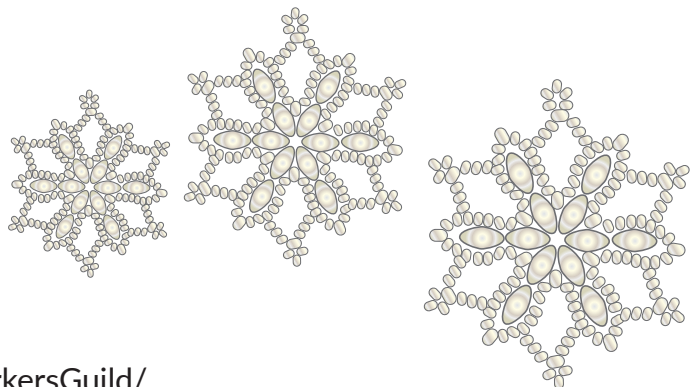
These Wee Snowflakes are the cutest little decorations, measuring just 30mm from point to point. They are a super quick lightweight make - perfect for earrings, decorations or to add a special touch to a loved ones present!

## Materials needed

### For one snowflake:

- 12 x superduos (A)
- 0.5g x size 15 seed bead (B)
- 0.5g x size 11 seed beads (C)
- Size 10 beading needle
- Beading thread of choice



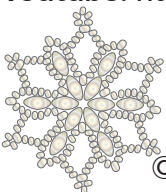

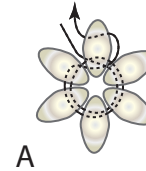

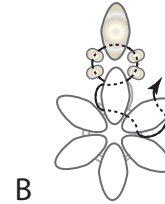
**Step 1.** Pick up 6xA and thread through them all again to bring them round into a circle. Thread through the first one again and continue up through into the second hole.

(Diag A)



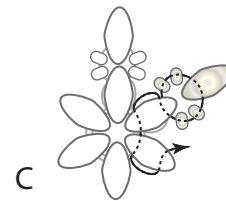
**Step 2.** Pick up 2xB, 1xA and 2xB, thread through the second hole of the A bead first exited once more, and down into the first hole (in the original circle). Thread through the next A bead along, and continue up through into the second hole.

(Diag B)



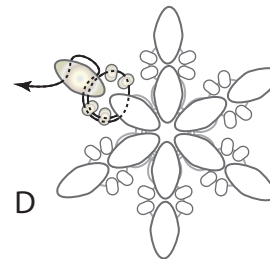
**Step 3.** Repeat Step 2 four more times. Pick up 2xB, 1xA and 2xB, thread through the second hole of the A bead first exited once more and into the 2xB and 1xA just added. Continue through the second hole in the A bead.

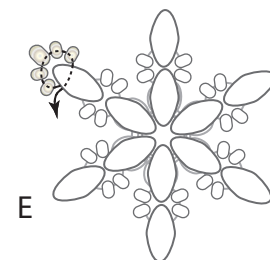
**Step 4.** Pick up 2xB, 1xC and 2xB and thread through the second hole of the A bead once more.

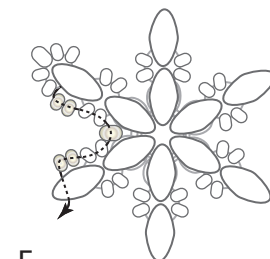


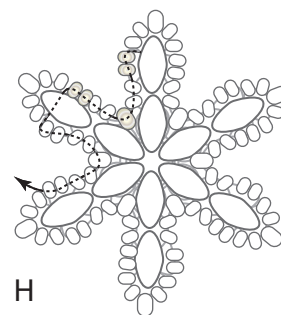
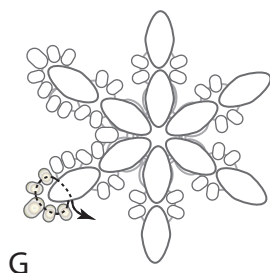
**Step 5.** Pick up 2xB and thread down through the 2 B beads directly below. Pick up 1xC and thread up through the next 2 B beads along. Pick up 2xB and thread through the second hole (closest to the edge) of the next A bead along.

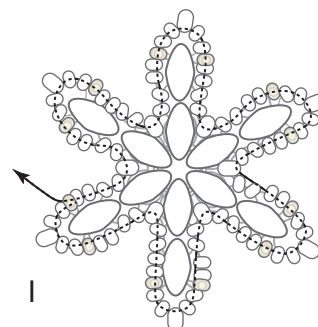
**N.B.** Don't worry if the beads seem a little loose around the superduo; it will firm up in the next few steps.



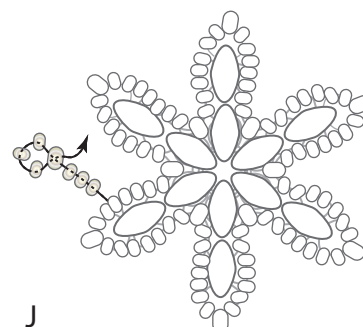


**Step 6.** Repeat Steps 4&5 five more times, pull the thread taught and thread through the next 4 B, 1 C and 4 B beads.  
(Diags G&H)

**Step 7.** Pick up 1xB and thread through the next 2 B beads. Ignoring the C bead, continue through the next 2 B beads. Pick up 1xB and thread through the next 4 B, 1 C and 4 B beads. This should fill in any gaps, firm up the snowflake and help the C bead to 'pop' out at the point.

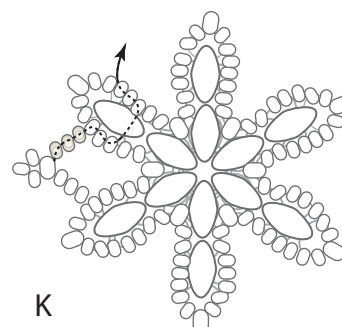


**Step 8.** Repeat Step 7 five more times, and continue through the first B bead added.  
(Diag I)



**Step 9.** Pick up 3xB, 1xC and 3xB. Thread back through the C bead, to form a picot.  
(Diag J)

**Step 10.** Pick up 3xB and thread down through the third B bead down from the C bead at the point on the next 'arm' of the snowflake (added in Step 7). Continue through the next 2 B beads and the second hole in the A bead. Continue through 3 B beads towards the direction of the point on the other side of the 'arm'.  
(Diag K)



**Step 11.** Repeat Steps 9&10 four more times. For the final repeat, pick up 3xB, 1xC and 5xB and thread back through the C bead to form a loop. Repeat Step 10 once more, and secure and trim thread ends.
