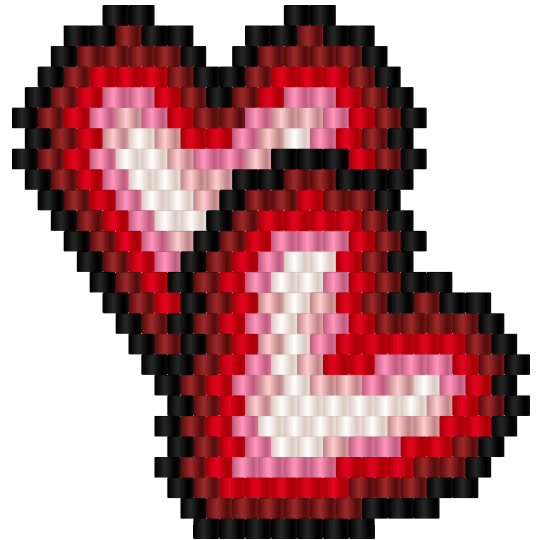

1 Parameters of the earrings from the photo

The earrings you can see on the first page are made of beads Miyuki Delica 11.
This pattern is for brick stitch.

Columns and rows: 21 columns x 26 rows

Approximate dimensions after sewing: 1,4 in x 1,4 in
36 mm x 34 mm

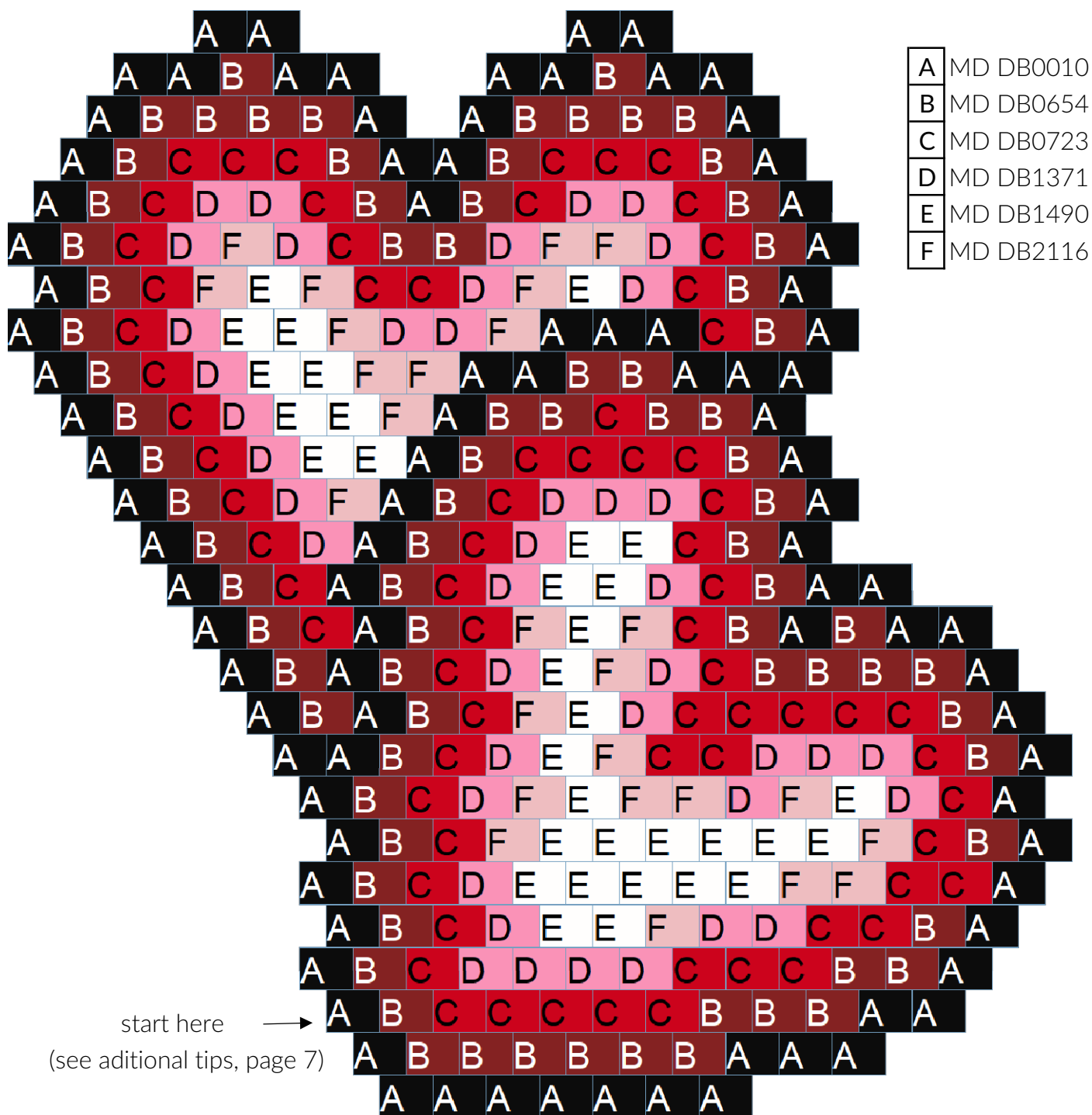


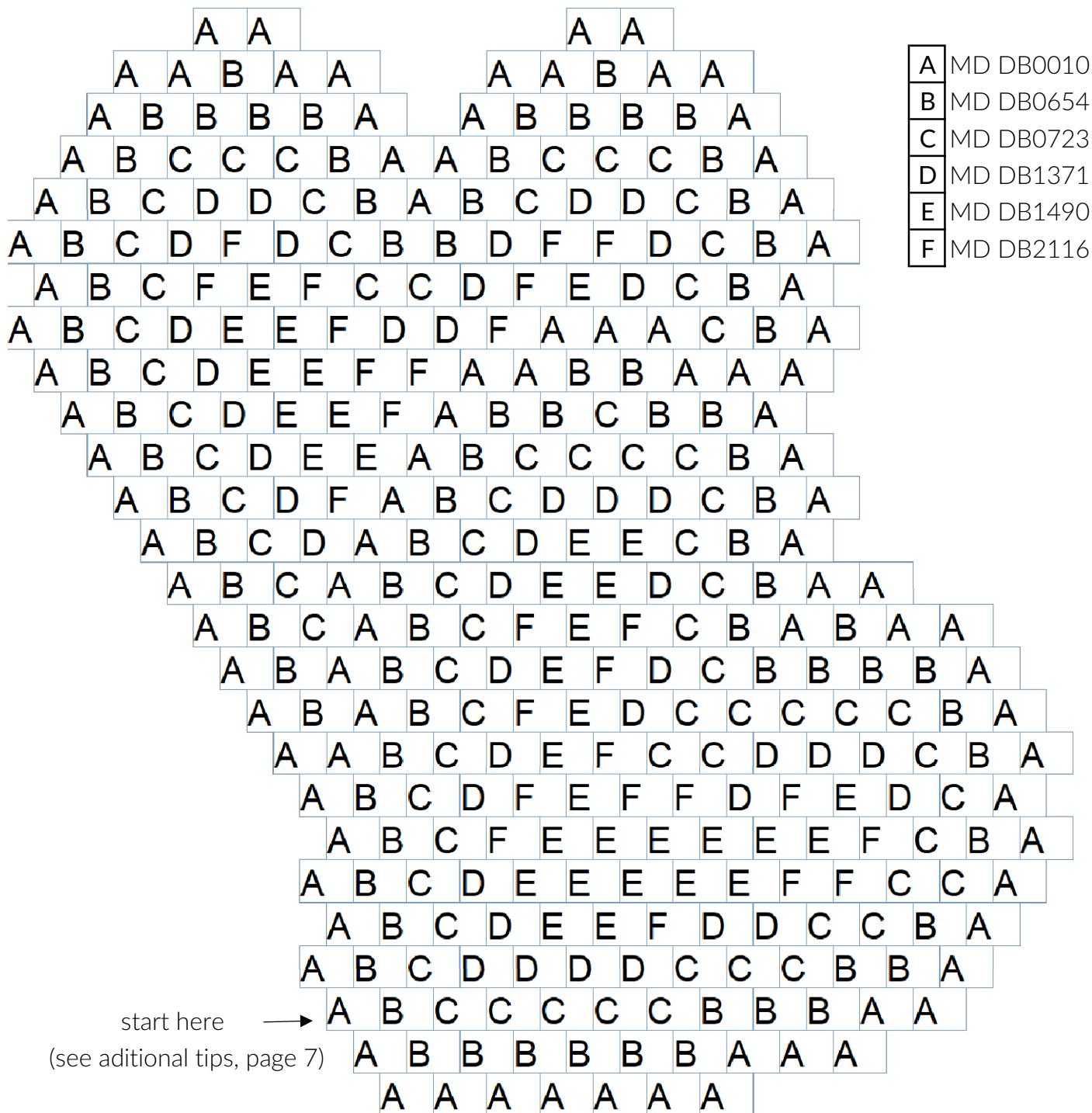
3 Three kinds of pattern

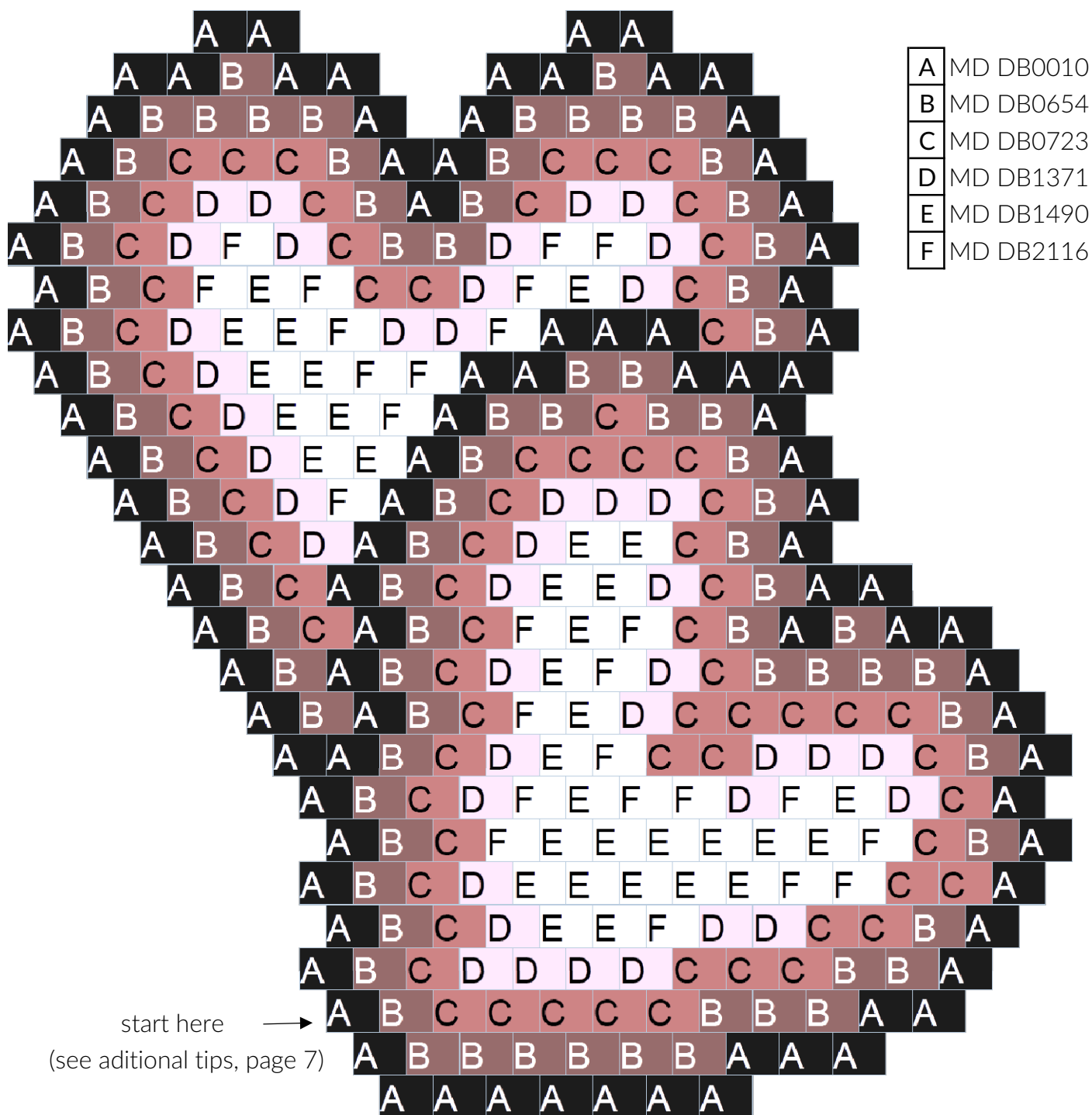
Below you will find three versions of the same pattern (each page ready to print, if you like to work with a printed pattern):

- full with letters and colors
- only letters (you can color it with your own palette)
- letters and pale colors (print friendly if you like to see shades in print)

I suggest you start beading from the row 3 (read additional tips on page 7).







4 **JPG file**

You also have a separate .jpg file attached to this pattern.
Useful if you prefer to stitch from the digital version.

I like to open it e.g. in Paint and cross out each beaded row.

5 **Additional tips**

I suggest you start with row 3. This row is wider than 1 and 2, so it will be easier to start here.
When you'll finish row 4 you can weave your thread down, stitch row 2 and 1, and weave up again to stitch rows 5, 6 and so on.

per one earring

The first row of the word chart is the bottom row of the earring, so read down but stitch up.

(R) means you are starting from left to right

(L) from right to left

Have a nice beading and a nice day :)
