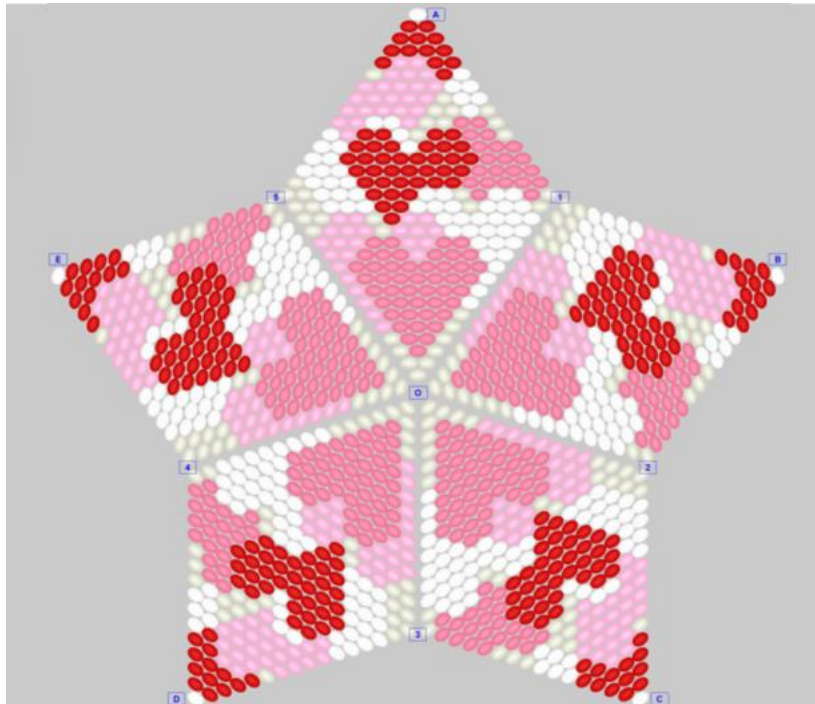


Patchwork Hearts – 3D Peyote Star pattern.

This pattern assumes you can make peyote warped squares



Beads

Miyuki Delica size 11

A DB0246 (LIGHT PINK) Count 475

B DB0202 (WHITE) Count 584

C DB0035 (SILVER) Count 347

D DB0420 (DARK PINK) Count 662

E DB0602 (RED) Count 497

Points Swarovski 4mm Xilion Bicones (Siam) Count 5

Loop Size 11 Delica (colours of your choice) Count 80

Thread

Approx 3 yards of thread per ray (I use 3 arm lengths). I use Miyuki nylon beading thread in white (Colour 2)

Other items

Handful of stuffing (soft toy stuffing, bubble wrap or cut up plastic bags).

Beading needle

Scissors

Lighter

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Rows, 16 weaving clockwise.

1. (4C)
2. (2C), (2C), (2C), (2D)
3. (1B+1C), 1C, (2C), 1C, (1C+1B), 1D, (2D), 1D
4. (1B+1C), 1C, 1B, (2B) 1B, 1C, (1C+1B), 1B, 1D, (2D), 1D, 1B
5. (1B+1A), 1C, 2B (2B), 2B, 1C, (1A+1B), 2B, 1D (2D), 1D, 2B
6. (1B+1A), 1A, 3B, (2B), 3B, 1A, (1A+1B), 2B, 2D, (2C), 2D, 2B
7. (1B+1A), 2A, 3B, (2A), 3B, 2A, (1A+1B), 3B, 2D, (2C), 2D, 3B
8. (1B+1A), 2A, 2B, 1E, 1A, (2A), 1A, 1E, 2B, 2A, (1A+1B), 3B, 3D, (2C), 3D, 3B
9. (1B+1A), 1D, 2A, 1B, 2E, 1A (2A), 1A, 2E, 1B, 2A, 1D, (1A+1B), 1D, 2B, 4D, (2B), 4D, 2B, 1D
10. (1B+1A), 2D, 1A, 1B, 3E, 1A, (2A), 1A, 3E, 1B, 1A, 2D, (1A, 1B), 2D, 1B, 1C, 1D, 1E, 1D, 1B, (2B), 1B, 1D, 1E, 1D, 1C, 1B, 2D
11. (1C+1A), 3D, 1C, 3E, 1B, 1A, (2C), 1A, 1B, 3E, 1C, 3D, (1A+1C), 3D, 1B, 1C, 2E, 1D, 1B, (2B), 1B, 1D, 2E, 1C, 1B, 3D
12. (1C+1A), 3D, 1C, 4E, 2A, (2E), 2A, 4E, 1C, 3D, (1A+1C), 3D, 2B, 3E, 1C, 1B, (2E), 1B, 1C, 3E, 2B, 3D
13. (2C), 4D, 4E, 1B, 2A, (2E), 2A, 1B, 4E, 4D, (2C), 4D, 2B, 2E, 2C, 1E (2E), 1E, 2C, 2E, 2B, 4D
14. (2C), 4D, 1A, 3E, 1B, 3A, (2E), 3A, 1B, 3E, 1A, 4D, (2C), 4D, 1A, 1B, 3E, 1C, 1A, 1E, (2E), 1E, 1A, 1C, 3E, 1B, 1A, 4D
15. (2C), 4D, 2A, 2E, 1B, 3A, 1E, (2E), 1E, 3A, 1B, 2E, 2A, 4D (2C), 4D, 2A, 1B, 2E, 1C, 2A, 1E, (2E), 1E, 2A, 1C, 2E, 1B, 2A, 4D
16. ZIP ROW (1C), 4D, 2A, 1B, 2E, 1C, 3A, 1E, (1B), 1E, 3A, 1C, 2E, 1B, 2A, 4D (1C).

Repeat 5 times to form 5 rays (warped squares).

You will need to tidy up the tail threads by weaving some of them back through the rays and trimming. Two long tails over the 5 rays will be sufficient to zip up the star.

Weave the rays together.

The edge with the zip row against the edge without.

Zip up from the centre (silver) to the point (red & white) add 1 bicone bead and 1B bead, thread back through the bicone and add another 1B bead and continue zipping up to the centre of the other side (silver).

On the last ray, zip up to the point (red & white), add 1 bicone, 1B bead. At this point I add a hanging loop, add 80 Delica beads (a mix of B,C and E) to the thread, then thread the needle back through the first B bead before threading back through the bicone and pick up 1B bead and thread through the first E bead of the ray. Stuff the inside, then continue to zip up.

To finish off tighten the middle by threading the needle round the 5 beads at the points in the centre of the star, pull them together to tighten and thread through these beads a few more times.

Then push the needle through the centre of the star so that it comes out on the opposite side, in the centre, repeat the steps to tighten the centre.

Weave the thread off into one of the rays and trim off the tail.

When you trim the tail threads you may need to use a lighter to finish off, so you no longer see the thread.
