

Hookin' to the Beat – Dragonfly Pen Wrap No. 6

Even count peyote

This pattern uses the 2-row start method

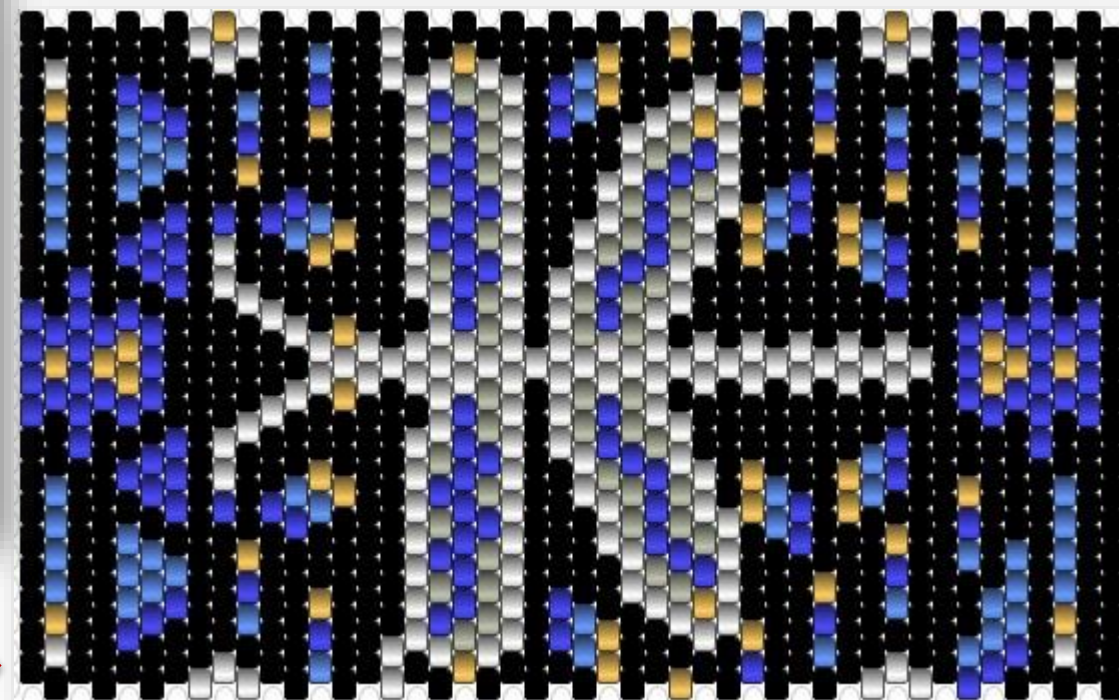
The number of beads to be used for any particular colour will be shown in the box for that colour together with the letter (ie 2A, 4G, etc.)

	Colour	No. of beads for entire design
A	White	147
B	Metallic Gold	50
C	Black	524
D	Cobalt Blue	132
E	Metallic Silver	46
F	Medium Blue	67
Design size 46 columns x 42 peyote rows		



Knowledge of even count peyote stitch is assumed

Please note that this particular pattern belongs to Hookin' to the Beat and, as such, should not be used except for your own personal use. You may sell the items you make from this pattern, but not the pattern itself!

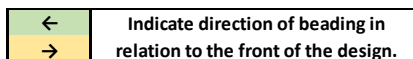

Hookin' to the Beat – Dragonfly Pen Wrap No. 6

Even count peyote

This set of written instructions works from the bottom towards the top of the design and starts with a combined Rows 1 & 2.
 This combined pair of rows will start at the bottom left and work towards the bottom right.



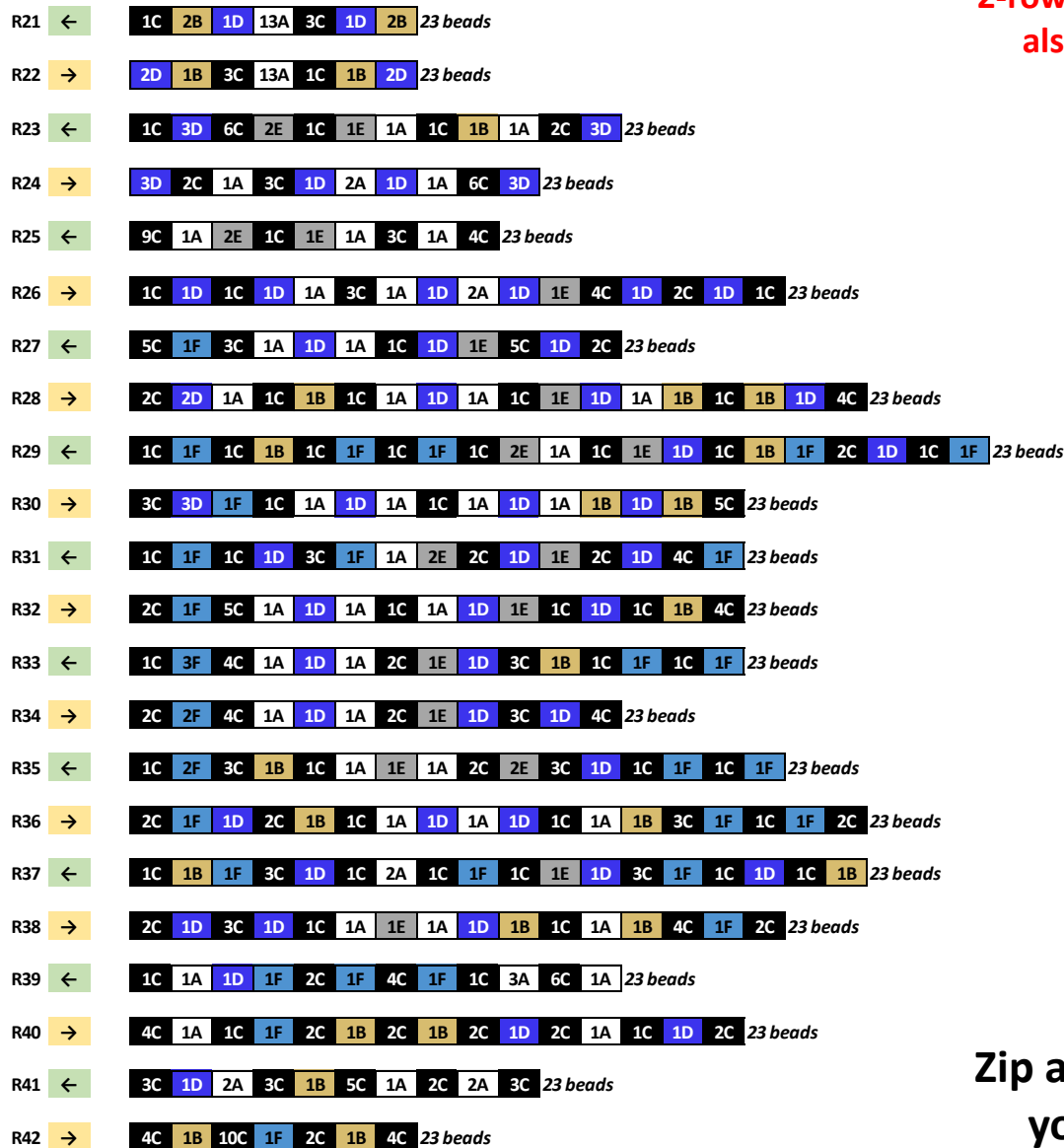
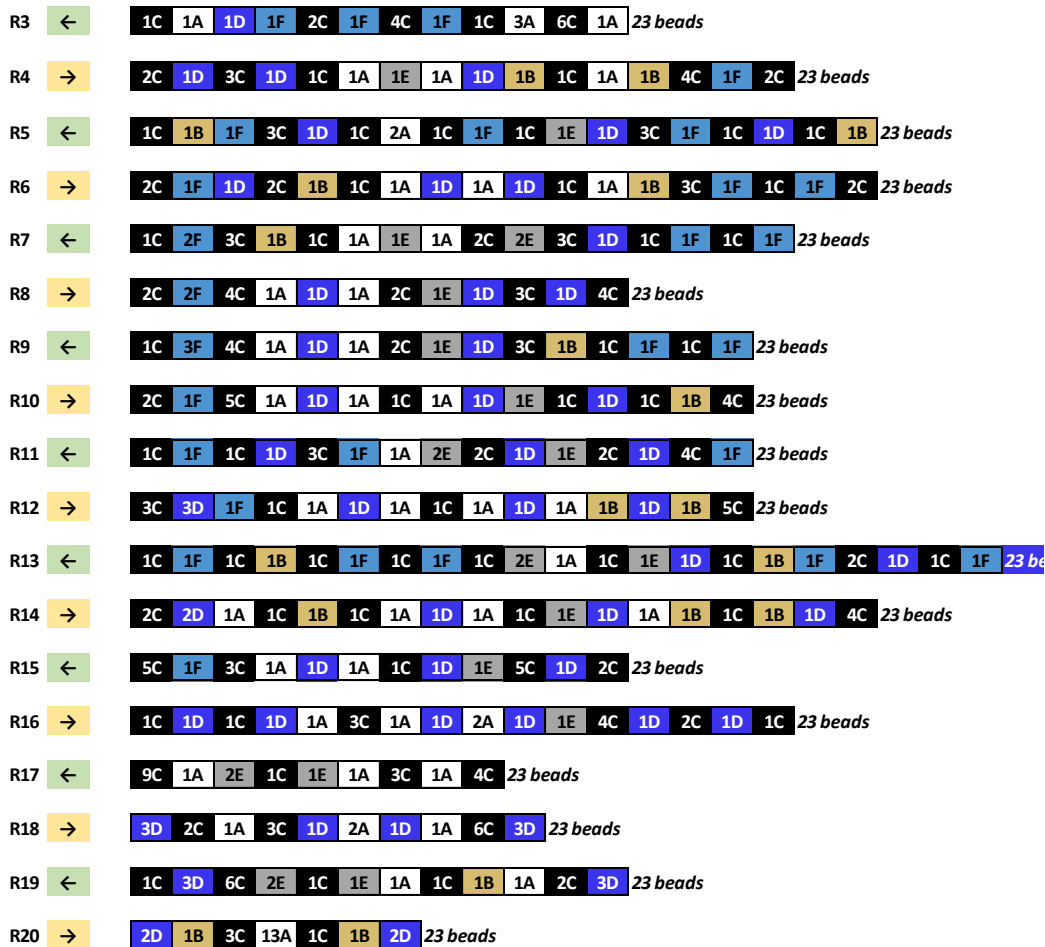
Rows 1 & 2 **7C 3A 2C 1F 2C 1A 2C 1B 5C 1B 2C 1B 2C 1D 4C 3A 1C 2D 5C** 46 beads (23 for Row 1 & 23 for Row 2)

However, if you prefer using a peyote starter strip, then:

Row 1 will start from the bottom right and will be: **3C 1D 2A 3C 1B 5C 1A 2C 2A 3C** ← 23 beads

Row 2 will work from left to right and will be: **4C 1A 1C 1F 2C 1B 2C 1B 2C 1D 2C 1A 1C 1D 2C**

This pattern uses the 2-row start method but also provides starter strip rows (within box to the left).



Zip and add to your pen
