## Cheers!

From Bead Soup in Savage, Maryland
Materials
Beading Needle (size 10)*
Beading Thread (fireline 6lb)*
11/0 delica (DB1788) A (1.2g)
11/0 delica (DB200), B (.9g)
11/0 delica (DB0042), C (.25)
15/0 seed bead (matte trans green) D (. 6 g )
15/0 seed bead (white), E (. 2 g )
15/0 seed bead (duracoat gold), F (.7g)
Pink Champagne-15/0 S/L Blush AB, G (2g)
11/0 S/L Blush AB, H (1.2g)
2 mm rounds (8 beads)
White stuffing material
*not included in kit


Thread a needle with a generous wingspan of fireline.

Round 1-Pick up 7 D beads. Slide down the thread leaving enough of a tail to weave in later. Go through all the beads from the tail side. Continue through the first 2 beads (black line).

Round 2-Pick up a D and go through the next $D$ from round 1. Repeat 6 times. Step up $1^{\text {st }} D$ added in this round (red line).


Round 3-Peyote an A. Repeat 6 times. Step up $1^{\text {st }} A$ added in this round (black line).

Round 4-Peyote 2 D beads together. Repeat 6 times. Step up $1^{\text {st }}$ D added in this round (red line).

Round 5—Pick up a D and go through the next $D$ from round 4. Peyote an A going through the $1^{\text {st }} D$ of the next pair added in round 4 . Repeat his sequence 6 times. Step up $1^{\text {st }} D$ added (purple line).

Round 6-Peyote an A. Repeat 13 times. Step up $1^{\text {st }} A$ (blue line).

The following section is tubular peyote with 14 beads in each round. There will be a step up at the end of each round.

For rounds 7-31 refer to the next diagram:
Round 7-Repeat round 6.

Round 8-Repeat round 6.
Round 9—Repeat round 6.
Round 10-Repeat round 6.
Round 11-Repeat round 6.
Round 12-Repeat round 6.


Round 13-Peyote a B. Repeat 13 times. Step up $1^{\text {st } B . ~}$

Round 14—Repeat round 13.

Round 15-Peyote a C. Repeat 13 times. Step up $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{C}$.

Round 16—Peyote a B. Repeat 13 times. Step up $1^{\text {st }} B$.

Round 17, 18,19 and 20—Repeat round 16.
Round 21-Peyote (5)B, (9)C. Step up $1^{\text {st }} B$.
Round 22 - Peyote (4)B, (1)C, (8)B, (1)C. Step up $1^{\text {st }}$ B added.
Round 23 - Peyote (3)B, (1)C, (9)B, (1)C. Step up $1^{\text {st }} B$ added.
Round 24 - Peyote (2)B, (1)C, (1)B, (8)A, (1)B, (1)C. Step up $1^{\text {st }} B$ added.
Round 25- Peyote (1)B, (1)C, (1)B, (9)A, (1)B, (1C). Step up $1^{\text {st }} C$ added.
Round 26-Peyote (1)C, (1)B, (10)A, (1)B, (1)C. Step up $1^{\text {st }}$ B.
Round 27 -Peyote (1)B, (11)A, (1)B,(1)C. Step up $1^{\text {st }} B$.
Round 28-Peyote (12)A, (2)B. Step up $1^{\text {st }} A$.
Round 29- Peyote (5)A, (1)D, (6)A, (1)E, (1)A. Step up $1^{\text {st }} A$.
Round 30-Peyote (1)A, (1)D, (6)A, (1)D, (5)A. Step up $1^{\text {st }} A$.
Round 31- Peyote (2)A, (1)D, (1)A, (1)D, (1)A, (1)D, (2)A, (1)D, (1)A, (1)D, (1)A, (1)D. Step up $1^{\text {st } A}$ added.

For rounds 32-35 refer to the next diagram:


Round 32-Peyote 14 D. Step up $1^{\text {st }} D$
Round 33-Peyote (1)A, (6)D, (1)A, (2)D, (1)E, (3)D. Step up1st A.
Round 34-Peyote (9)D, (2)E, (3)D. Step up $1^{\text {st }} D$.
Round 35-Peyote (9)E, (1)F, (4)E. Step up $1^{\text {st }}$ E.

If desired, add stuffing at this point to keep the tube from collapsing.

For rounds 36-40 refer to the following diagram.


Round 36 -Peyote (5)E. Go through the next round 35 E without adding a bead. Peyote (2)E, (2)F, (2)E. Go through the next E without adding a bead. Peyote an E. Step up $1^{\text {st }} E$ added in this round (black line).

Round 37-Peyote (6)F, (1)E, (1)F, (1)E, (3)F. Step up $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{F}$ (red line).

Round 38-Peyote (1)F. Go through the next F without adding a bead. Peyote (3)F. Go through the following E without adding a bead. Peyote (2)E, (1)F. Go through the following F without adding a bead. Peyote (2)F. Step up $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{F}$ added in this round (purple line).

Round 39—Peyote (4)F, (1)E, (4)F. Step up $1^{\text {st } F}$ (blue line).

Round 40-Peyote (9)F. Step up $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{F}$ (green line)


Round 41-Go through the next $F$ without adding a bead. Peyote (2)F. Repeat this sequence twice. Step up $1^{\text {st }} F$ added (black line).

Round 42 -Peyote (6)F. Step up $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{F}$ added (red line).

Rounds 43, 44, 45, 46, 47 and 48-Repeat round 42.


Round 49 -Peyote (6)D. Step up $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{D}$ (black line).
Round 50-Peyote (6)D. Step up $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{D}$ (redline). Go through all 6 D beads just added (purple line). Step down 1 D.


Round 51—Exiting a round 49 D, stitch in ditch with A. Repeat 5 times. Step up $1^{\text {st }} A$ (black line).

Round 52-Peyote (2D) beads together in the space between each A (12 beads total). Step up first 2 D's added in this round (red line).


Round 53-Peyote (1)D going through the 2D's added in round 52. Repeat 5 times. Step up $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{D}$ (black line).

Round 54—Peyote (1)D. Repeat 5 times. Step up $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{D}$ added (red line). Go through the 6 beads just added (purple line). Secure and end the tails.

Round 55, adding a bail-Pick up 1G, 2H and 18F beads. Slide down. Skip the last 18F beads. Go back
 through the 2 H beads. Pick up a G. Skip the next 2 round 54 D beads and go through the following D . Go back through the last G added. Go back through the 2 H and 18 F beads. Go back through the 2 H beads and the $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{G}$ bead. Go through the $D$ the bail started in. Step down 1 D.

Round 56, adding the champagne fringe-The fringe is added between th e round 53 beads. Pick up 3 H beads.


Pick up ( $2 \mathrm{G}^{\prime} \mathrm{s}$ ) and an H (the beader can decide the length, up to 15 sets of beads). Pick up a G. Turn and go back through the last H .

For the next 2 spaces, skip the 2 G 's and go through the following H .

Peyote the rest of the spaces with G for a tight curl or with H for a looser curl. For the last stitch peyote an H . Keep a tight tension. At the end, move through the next round 53 bead.

Repeat 5 times to fringe between each bead but vary the length of each fringe..

Round 57-Embellish the fringe by attaching 2 mm pearls to the fringe beads as desired.

Secure and end the thread and any tails.
