## **Rainbow Fish Pin**

## Requirements

Delica beads in the following colour (see bead count in brackets):

- o Matt black (195)
- o Green (45)
- o Blue (38)
- Yellow (41)
- o Orange (24)
- Violet (37)
- o Purple (21)
- White only 1 bead

Usual bead kit (needle, thread etc) Brooch or pin of choice

Using Brick stitch, a ½ yard of chosen thread on your needle, and starting at the midpoint (shown with the arrow), work up the chart on the right to create the first half of the fish, then re-join at the start and bead the second half.

To make up, add a brooch or pin to the back.

By using seed beads, you can produce a piece of work which is slightly more fluid and allows a small amount of stuffing to give the piece a 3D effect. Bead two identical pieces and join the around the edge with an overhand stitch through the visible threads – it could then be used as a charm.

I also used matt black which allowed the rainbow colours to 'pop'.
