Hookin' to the Beat – 3D Peyote Pod – Emergency Services (Police)

The number of beads to be used for any particular colour will be shown in the box for that colour together with the letter (ie 2A, 4G, etc.)

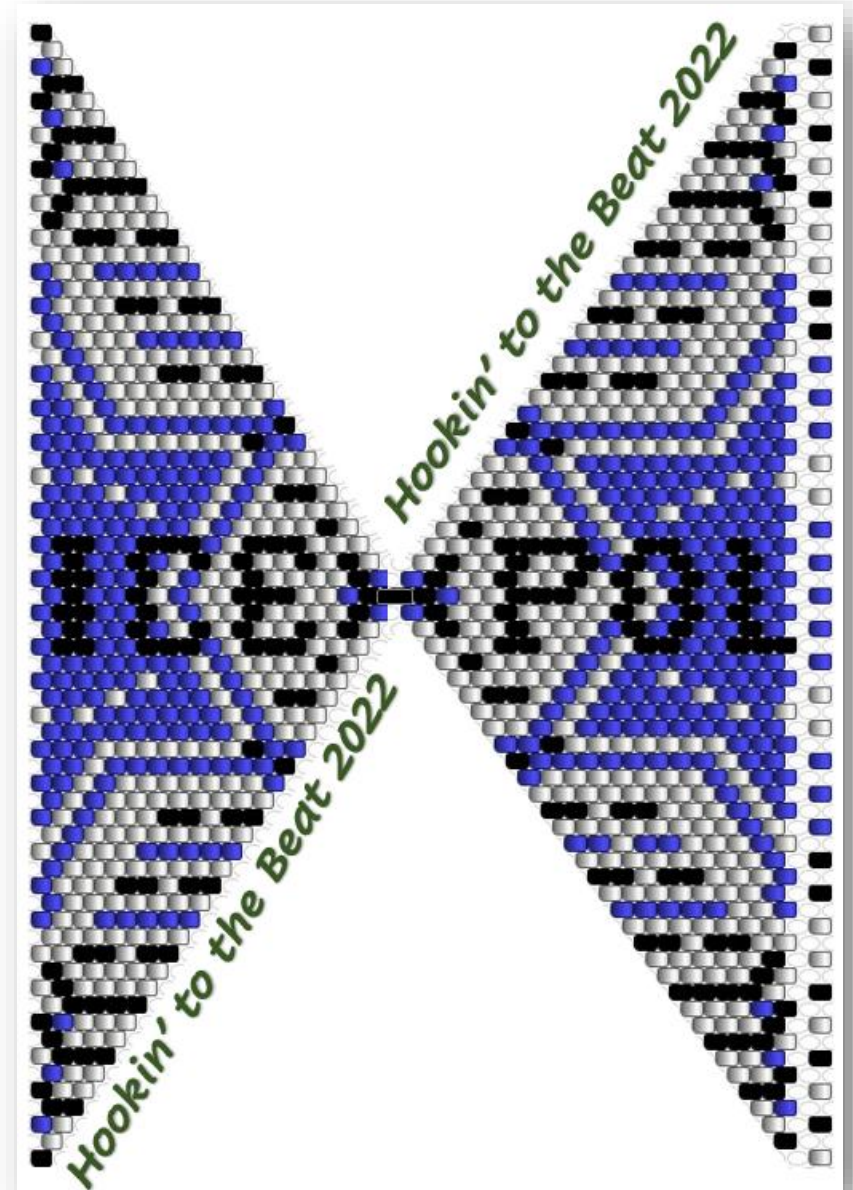
However, where a number/letter combo is shown in brackets such as (4A) or (2A), this indicates that the beads should be woven together such as in the base round or in corner herringbone stitches.

Code	Colour	No. of beads for 2 pod pieces	No. of beads for 3 pod pieces	No. of beads for 4 pod pieces
A	White	1,178	1,767	2,356
B	Cobalt Blue	818	1,227	1,636
C	Black	454	681	908

You may sell the items you make from this pattern, but not the pattern itself!



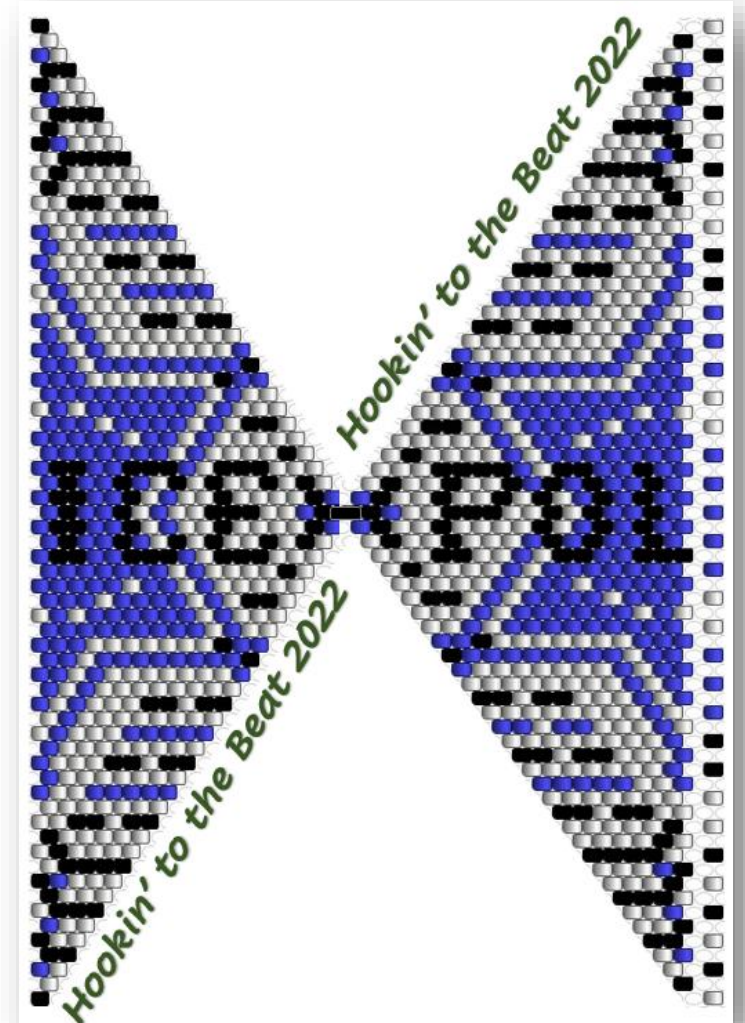
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R1 & 2 (C B B) Pass needle back through 1st bead, knot and then add (B B) Then, pass the needle back through to make the following:

Zip Row Once Row 34 is done, do an extra row on next side to enable zipping of the pod pieces together:
