Radiant Rainbow - IBW 2026 3D Peyote Star Tutorial



Materials, tools, techniques

Materials: thread (6lb Fireline or similar), 11/0 cylinder beads (i.e., Delicas, Aikos, Cylins) - ~5g for 8 row star total, closed jump ring (optional)

Tools: #10 needle, thread cutter

Techniques: Spiral/Circular geometric Peyote stitch

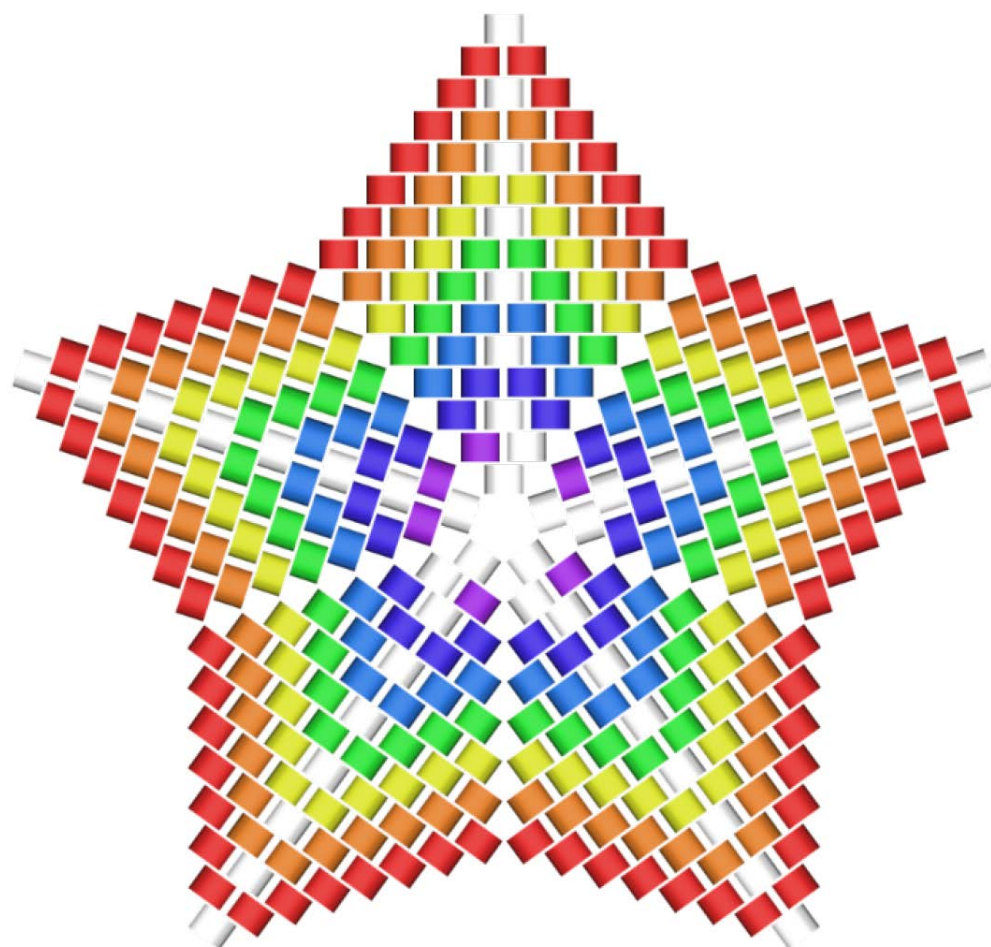
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Beads used in pattern

Bead	Symbol	Count	Description
	A	79	White
	B	110	Red
	C	100	Orange
	D	90	Yellow
	E	80	Green
	F	70	Blue
	G	60	Indigo
	H	46	Purple

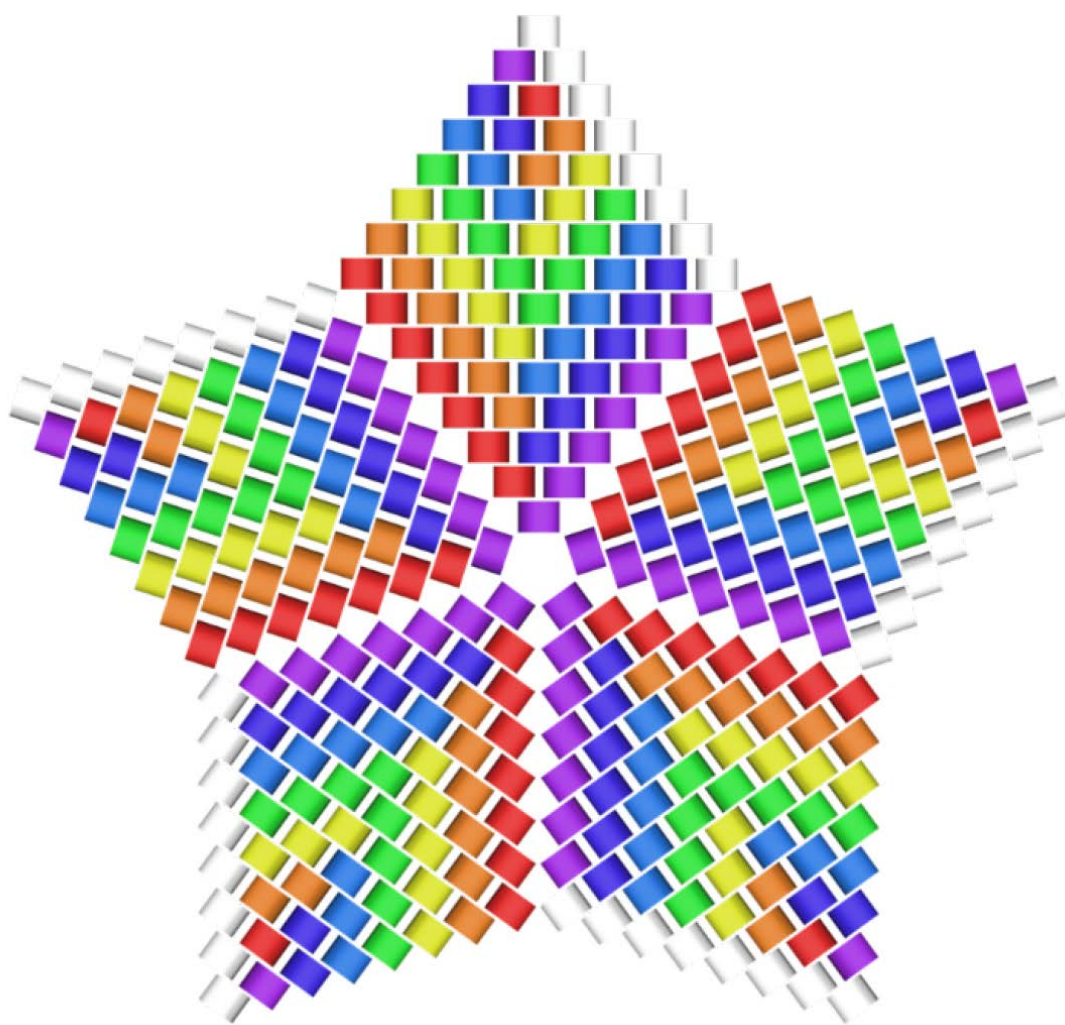
This beads-used list is meant to be a suggestion of colors you can use/replace with beads from your own stash.

Row 4:
(2E), 1D, 1C
(1B, 1A), 1F, 1G
(1H, 1B), 1C, 1D
(1E, 1B), 1C, 1D

Row 5:
(2F), 1E, 1D, 1C
(1B, 1A), 1E, 1F, 1G
(1H, 1B), 1C, 1D, 1E
(1F, 1B), 1C, 1D, 1E

Row 6:
(2G), 1F, 1E, 1D, 1C
(1B, 1A), 1D, 1E, 1F, 1G
(1H, 1B), 1C, 1D, 1E, 1F

(2H), 1G, 1F, 1E, 1D, 1C
